GUIDELINES FOR DOING YOUR RESEARCH AND WRITING YOUR PAPERS

- 1. Choose a *topic* that you *really like and can handle*.
- 2. Look for *bibliographical and web-based references* which deal with the topic. Consult *English* language *sources* and references *only*. Your *MUST GIVE ME A PHOTOCOPY OF THE ARTICLES YOU CONSULTED TO WRITE YOUR PAPER*.
- 3. Read the documents that deal with your topic, as follows:
 - a) **Read** the articles a first time in order to become acquainted with their contents.
 - b) **Read** the articles a second time and **underline** the words and expressions whose meanings and/or pronunciation you don't know or aren't sure of.
 - c) Look up the meanings of those words in a good monolingual English dictionary and their pronunciation in a pronunciation dictionary.
 - d) **Read** the articles a third time and try **to understand their contents**.
- 4. Write the paper in your own words: Don't just copy and paste! Remember: I'm interested in knowing how good your English is (grammar and vocabulary) and if you write coherently, not in your ability to copy and paste. Note: This activity will be done in extra class sessions under the supervision of the Language Assistant or the Teacher's Assistant (Preparador).
- 5. You must turn
- 6. Your paper (or essay) must have:
 - a) A *cover sheet* with your name, the title of your paper and the date when you will submit it.
 - b) An *introduction* (Subtitle).
 - c) **Body** containing a coherent development of your ideas.
 - d) A *conclusion* (Subtitle)
 - e) **References**. **Note**: You must **cite only the references** that you actually **used** to write your paper.

- 7. If you quote somebody's work, you *must give credit to the author(s)* or sources where you took the information from. *DO NOT PLAGIARIZE*!
- 8. Your paper *must* meet the following *requirements*:
 - a) It must be typewritten and double-spaced.
 - b) Margins: Top: 2.5 cm, Bottom: 2.5 cm; Left: 2.5 cm, Right: 2.5 cm.
 - c) Fonts: 12 points.
 - d) All pages (except the cover sheet) must be numbered at the bottom,
 - e) It must be five (05) pages long, excluding cover sheet, introduction, conclusions and references. Note: Your references must be written following the guidelines of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA).
- 9. A week after you turn in your paper, you must come to my office for an interview with me about the contents of your paper.
- 10. THE PAPERS MUST BE TURNED IN EXACTLY ON THE DATE AND TIME SET BY ME. ON NO ACCOUNT WILL EXTENSIONS BE GRANTED. No excuses will be accepted (e.g., the diskette damaged, the printer didn't work, and so on). ADVICE: Back up your information on a CD, pen drive, zip drive, hard disk)
