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## Adjectives and Adverbs Whose Final -ED Is Pronounced /-id/

There are a few adjectives ending in -ED, derived from verbs or not, whose -ED is also pronounced /-id/. Following is a list of such adjectives.
aged /'eid3id/ = very old
beloved /bi'lıvid/ = darling; dearly loved
blessed /'blesid/ = holy; sacred
crooked /'krukid/ = not straight or level; dishonest
cursed /'k3:rsid/ = damnable; hateful
cussed /'kısid/ = cursed; awkward and stubborn
deuced /'dussid/ = darned; extreme
dogged /'dpgid/ = obstinate; stubborn
jagged /'dzægıd/ = having sharp projecting points
learned /'l3:rnid/ = having much knowledge; erudite
naked /'nerkıd/ = without clothes on; nude
ragged /'rægıd/ = badly torn
rugged /'rıgid/ = rough; uneven; rocky
sacred /'seıkrıd/ = associated with God; not secular
striped /'straıpıd/ = marked with stripes
wicked /'wikıd/ = morally bad; evil
wretched /'ret $\int \mathrm{rd} /=$ unhappy; unsatisfactory

Similarly, when we add - $\boldsymbol{L Y}$ to some adjectives ending in $\boldsymbol{- E D}$, whether they are derived from verbs or not, the ending - $\mathbf{E D L Y}$ is pronounced /-Idlı/. Following is a list of such adverbs, their pronunciation and meaning.
assuredly /a'furidlı/ = surely; confidently
admittedly /əd'mıtıdlı/ = as an acknowledged fact
advisedly /əd'vaızıdlı/ = deliberately
allegedly /ə'led3ıdlı/ = so-called; supposedly
concernedly /kən's3:rnidlı/ = anxiously
confessedly /kən'fesıdlı/ = as confessed
confusedly /kən'fju:zidlı/ = not mentally soundly
declaredly /dr'lerıdlı/ = openly; admittedly
deservedly /dr'z3:rvidlı/ = justly; duly designedly /dı'zaınıdlı/ = intentionally determinedly /dr'ts:rmıdlı/ = resolutely deucedly /'duisidlı/ = extremely; confoundedly fixedly /'fiksidlı/ = in a fixed manner impassionedly /ım'pæfənıdlı/= ardently markedly /'markidlı/ = noticeably supposedly /sə'pouzıdlı/ = presumably surprisedly /sər'praızıdlı/ = unexpectedly
